**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
SHEEN LANE, SHEEN**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 7 April 2002 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Sheen Lane in Sheen from a point outside its entrance to Hill End Farm for a distance of 146 metres in a north easterly direction unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works. No pedestrian footways on road. Road plates for emergency vehicle access.

The order will come into operation on 15 April 2020 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 April 2020.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the Seven Trent Water works to install a new water connection, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
