**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC  
Pown Street  
Sheen**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 15th September 2020 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Pown Street in Sheen from its junction with Redway and continuing for a distance of approximately 450 metres in a generally north-easterly direction, unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Pedestrian access will be maintained and through access will not be available.

**The order will come into operation on 17th September 2020 and the said works (which will start at 08:00) will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19th September 2020 (at approximately 17:00).**

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the water connection works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
