**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
TINMAN LANE, HULME END**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 27 October 2020 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Tinman Lane in Hulme End from its junction with B5054 Mill Lane to its junction with Redway unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 2 November 2020 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date taking place between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4 December 2020.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the surface dressing pre-patching repair works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
