Brown bins:

There will be no brown bin collections from Monday 27th December through to Friday 7th January.

Collections of the brown bin will restart on Monday 10th January.

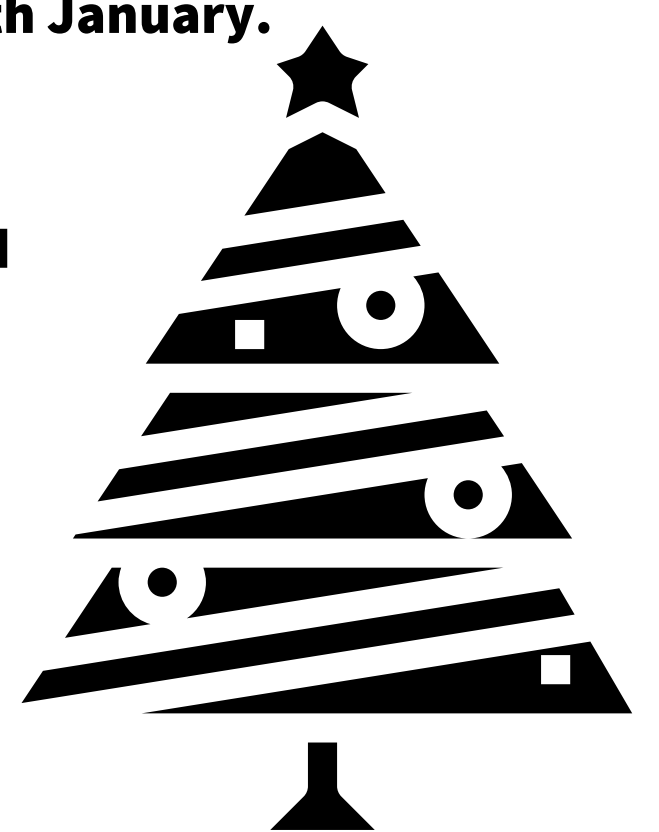
Please continue to use this bin as usual by putting in any vegetable peelings, cooked and uncooked foodwaste and any festive garden foliage.

Christmas Trees:

Natural Christmas trees should be cut up and placed inside the brown bin, or if less than 5ft tall, left whole beside the bin on collection day.

Trees can also be taken to recycling centres in Biddulph, Cheadle or Leek.

The Council does not operate a shredding service so please do not leave your tree in a car park. Dumping waste (including trees) is fly tipping and anyone caught could face prosecution and a fine of up to £50,000.
